


Stage 3 of Reopening Ontario

On Friday, July 24, at 12:01 a.m. Hamilton, Halton, Haldimand-Norfolk and Niagara moved into Stage 3 of the reopening of the Province.

As part of Stage 3, real estate open houses are permitted to continue. As such, RAHB members are able to schedule "Public", "Member", and "Virtual" open houses in Matrix.

Members must follow all guidelines provided by local and provincial health officials for physical distancing, the wearing of personal protective equipment, and the sanitization of hands and surfaces.
