
All walk-a-thon participants will automatically be registered for our virtual Wrap Up Party, but if you'd like to join us, please register **here** no later than October 20.

RAHB Government Relations Committee Meets with MPP Jane McKenna



On Friday, October 15, members of the RAHB Government Relations Committee, including Patrick Tomaszewski, Margaret Reid, Shawn Paterson, Michael Di Genova and Crystal Henderson, along with representatives from OREA, met with MPP Jane McKenna.

The group posed two recommendations to Ms. McKenna to address affordability including

- 1. Increasing the first-time home buyers land transfer tax rebate to \$8,000 and;
- 2. Introducing the "Bring Affordability Home Act, 2021".

The new "Bring Affordability Home Act, 2021" legislation would tackle increasing the supply of homes by redeveloping commercial properties into residential housing, incentivizing developers to turn surplus public land into residential housing, creating an Ontario-made shared-equity homeownership model, and more.
