Burlington State of the City Address

In her annual State of the City address last Thursday, Mayor Marianne Meed Ward touched on a variety of the ways that the city of Burlington can look forward to a bright future. Highlights include:

- Differentiating between mitigating overdevelopment versus being "antidevelopment."
- Reiterating that the provincial growth target for Burlington is more than 70,000 new people in the next 30 years, and that there are 68 active major development applications within the city.
- Noting that 132 building permits for dwellings were issued in 2021, including 68 single-detached dwellings, 41 townhouses and 23 apartments and condo projects.
- Noting the approval of a resolution not to open the Greenbelt for development.
- Noting that City Council approved the Housing Needs & Opportunities
 Report in December, which acknowledges that we consider housing a basic human right.
- Celebrating city support for the Habitat for Humanity build on Queensway Drive in support of helping families ladder up into private home ownership.
